Alexis Charles Henri Clerel de Tocqueville, a French nobleman and political scientist, traveled to the United States of America in 1831 to gain an understanding of democracy in hope of replacing the aristocratic European regime. Though his visit to America lasted only nine months, his deep appreciation for and new understanding of our culture lasted a lifetime.

In the historical treatise, *Democracy in America*, Tocqueville wrote a colorful description and analysis of the American way of life. He was most impressed with the way our citizens helped each other in times of need and attributed volunteerism as a way of life that was typically American. He said, "When an American asks for the cooperation of his fellow citizens, it is seldom refused; and I have often seen it afforded spontaneously, and with great goodwill."
