# EDUCATION



## Kindergarten Readiness

**BOLD GOAL:** Increase BRADD Area Kindergarten Readiness scores from 49.4% (2014) to 75% by the year 2020

- Train parents on kindergarten readiness activities
- Provide high quality early learning classrooms
- Connect families with available needed services
- Eliminate transportation barriers for kindergarten readiness camps
- Increase access to licensed childcare
- Provide in-classroom volunteer mentors

## College & Career Readiness

**BOLD GOAL:** Increase BRADD Area College & Career Readiness Scores from 65% (2014) to 80% by the year 2020

- Increase knowledge of soft skills in high school students
- Build character, leadership, and life skills outside of school
- Focus on literacy, science, and math
- Expand hands on learning activities in areas of STEM
- Create career pathways for students

# INCOME



## Workforce Development

- Provide training skills to increase wages of single parents while simultaneously providing low cost afterschool programming for their children
- Assist adults with obtaining the academic skills and credentials needed to transition to post-secondary education, function productively in the workforce, and support their families
- Supply resources for GED testing and certifications
- Assist adult learners in obtaining a GED and with a career pathway
- Provide English and industry vocabulary for job placement

# HEALTH



## Access to Affordable Health Care

- Educate long-term care residents on rights
- Offer substance abuse education and counseling before treatment
- Help individuals obtain insurance and treatment
- Provide access to vision, dental, health, and mental health services
- Provide drug prevention programming to students

## Safe Home & Community

- Give victims of domestic violence and their children a safe environment
- Educate children about bullying, sexual harassment, dating violence, and stalking
- Reduce child abuse and neglect through education
- Advocate and intervene for abused, neglected, and dependent children

# SAFETY NET



## Access to Basic Needs

- Provide food to children when at home
- Provide emergency housing for the homeless or those in crisis
- Fill in gaps in service for individuals in crisis
- Help single parents obtain child custody, housing, spousal support, and child support
- Assist individuals in crisis in securing basic needs for themselves and their children

## Transportation

- Supply residents with transportation options to get or maintain employment
- Provide transportation options to assist residents with access to basic needs (food, housing, health care, etc.)
